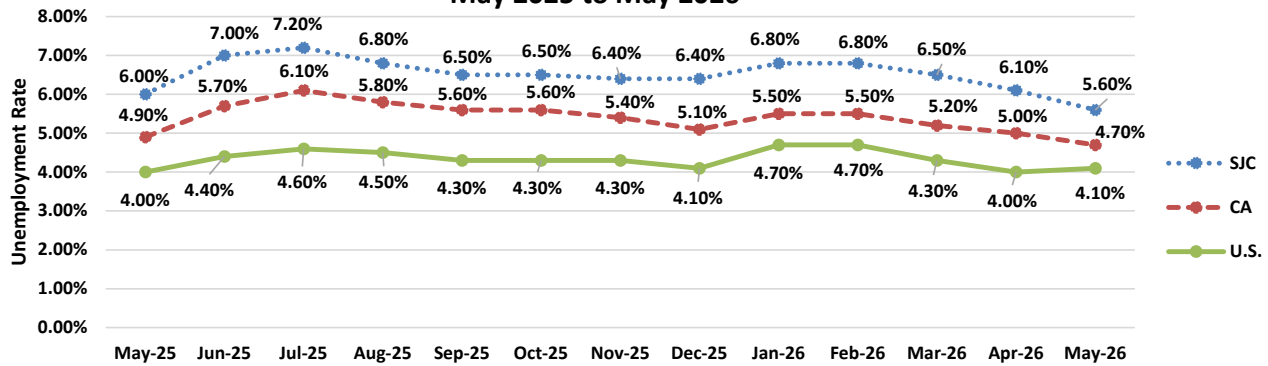

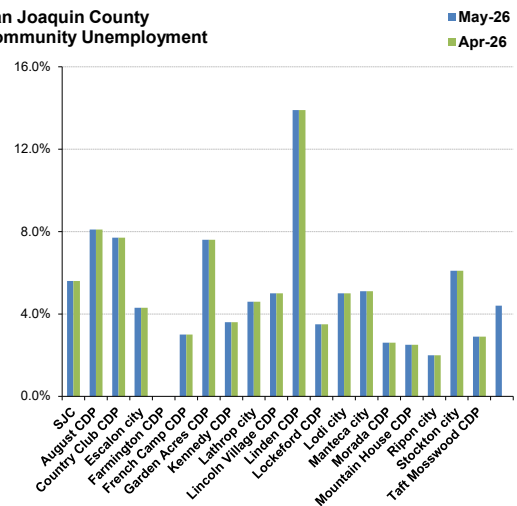
San Joaquin County, California, and the United States Unemployment Rates May 2025 to May 2026

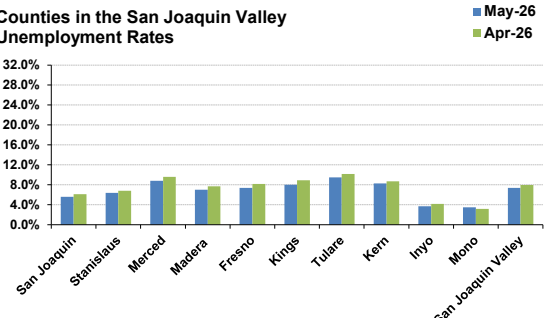
