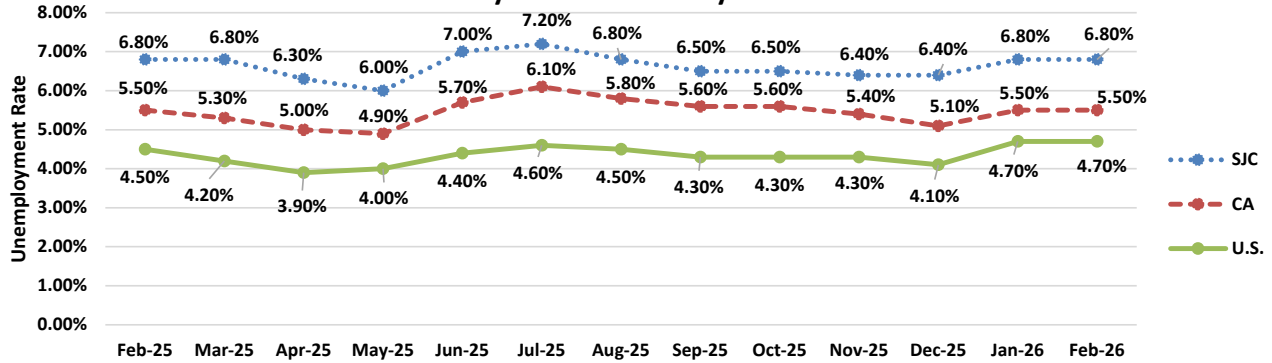

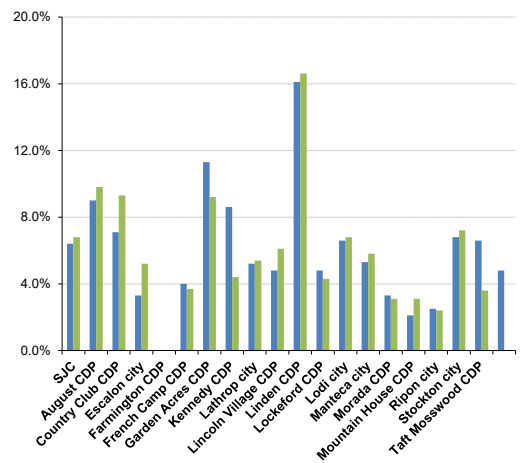
San Joaquin County, California, and the United States Unemployment Rates February 2025 to February 2026

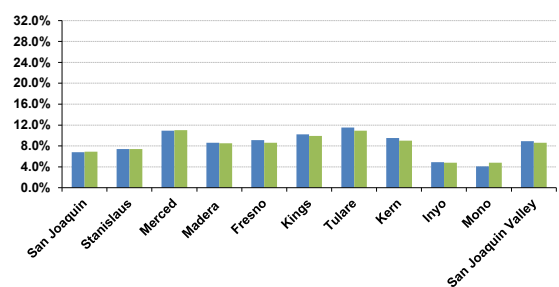
