

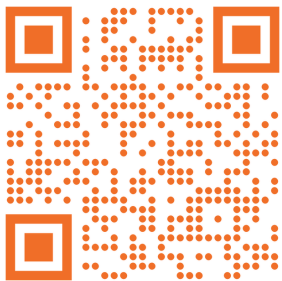

# DO YOU CARE FOR CHILDREN BUT NOT HAVE A LICENSE? DID YOU KNOW ...



You can **earn 4x as much income** with a license—after expenses, you can earn **\$50,000** in the central valley if you apply sound business practices and care for children with subsidies



There is a **high demand** for licensed child care in the central valley; subsidies are available to families earning up to about \$95,000 (family of 4)



In 12 weeks, you can get licensed, learn the basics of running a child care business and receive a **\$2,500** start-up funding



You can be a licensed home-based child care entrepreneur **regardless of your immigration status** or level of **education**



You can run a child care business from your home or apartment, **even if you are a renter**, as long as it is safe for children
