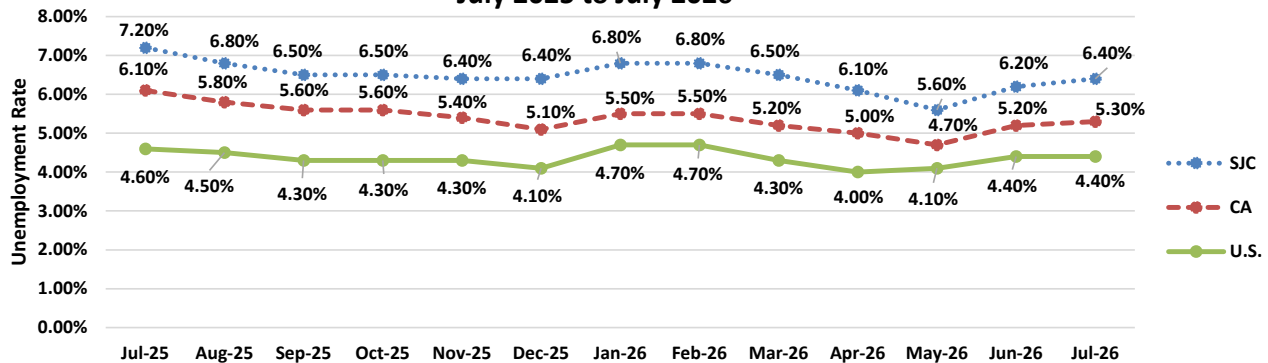

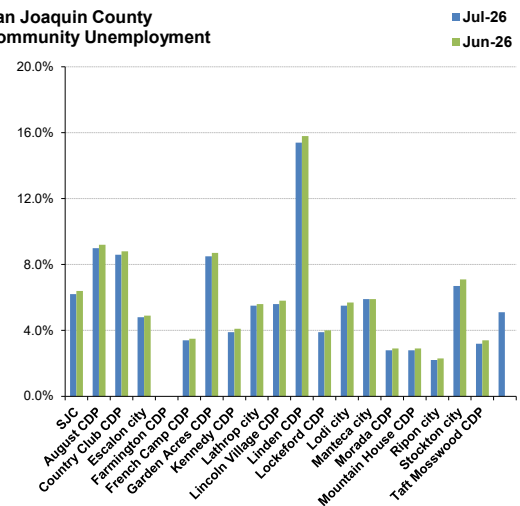
San Joaquin County, California, and the United States Unemployment Rates July 2025 to July 2026

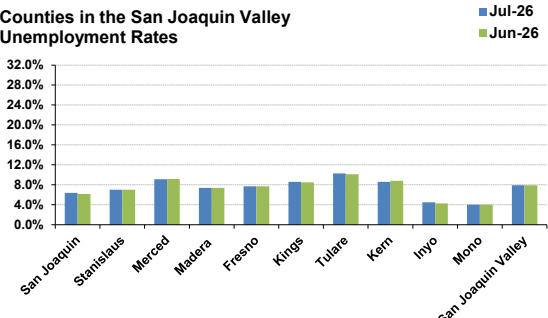
