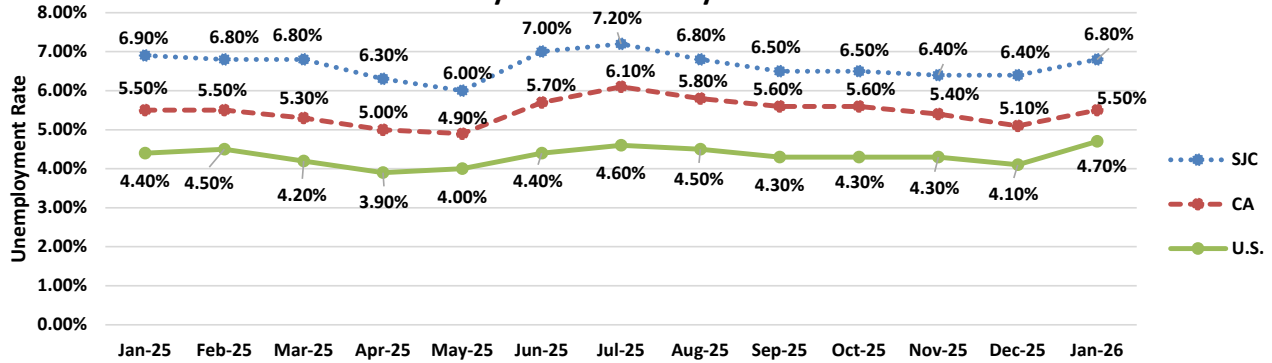

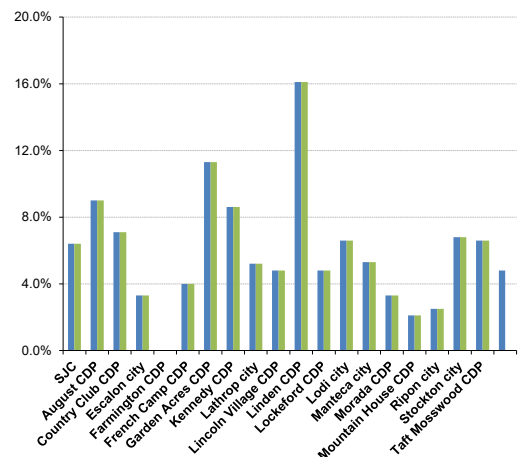
San Joaquin County, California, and the United States Unemployment Rates January 2025 to January 2026

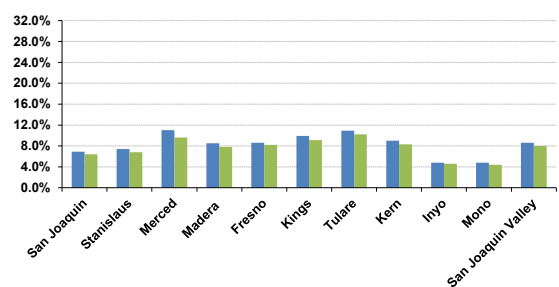
